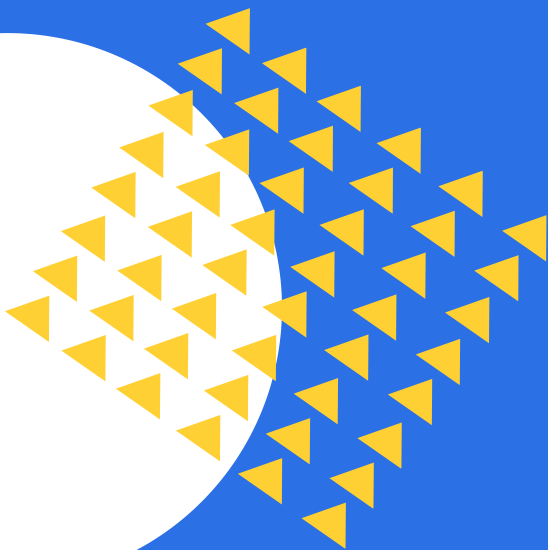


A bit of Context



The West Island (WI) is a vast territory, and it can be difficult to keep up with all the initiatives and projects taking place there. The network was therefore driven by a need to optimize communication channels between players in the food system, to facilitate collaboration and the pooling of resources.

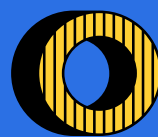


Vision

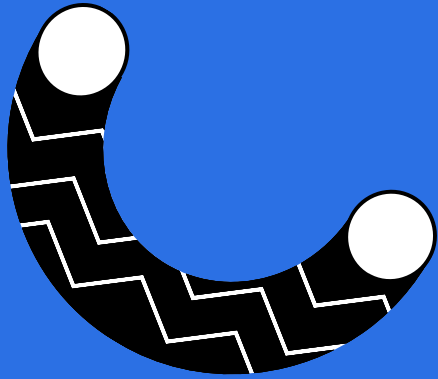
The vision represents the long-term picture we have for the Network project.

It brings together key players and facilitates the implementation of structuring initiatives aimed at strengthening the local food supply and reducing food insecurity in the West Island.

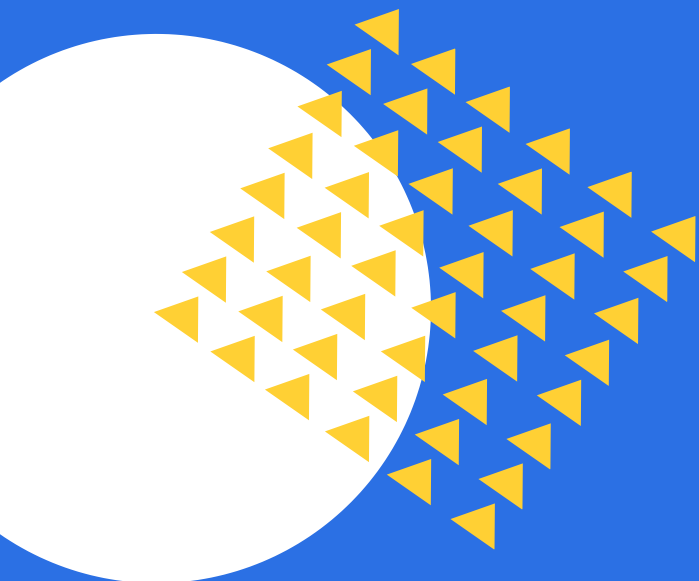
